## **Course Description**

Candidates are provided opportunities to ask questions and learn the structured course materials. The last day will include a written theory test and a topic teaching evaluation.

Upon successfully completing the program, instructors will be awarded with a Fall Protection Group Certified Instructor designation. They will have the knowledge and tools to deliver our Working At Heights program to other individuals. Tools provided include an electronic presentation, serialized student activations, and a detailed instructor binder to assist with all aspects of the program.
